## Summer Enrichment and Employment Program

The Summer Enrichment & Employment Project assists young African American males and females to strengthen their leadership and employment skills through training workshops and employment opportunities for youth in the city of Philadelphia. The project also provides the participants an opportunity to explore their culture. Nu Sigma Youth Services Summer Employment and Enrichment project was designed to assist young African Americans to strengthen their leadership and employment skills through career exploration seminars and employment opportunities.

### HISTORY

The initiative was established in 1992 and initially provided employment opportunities for 50 youth in North and South Philadelphia. The program has been expanded to employ over 200 youth from the city of Philadelphia. Nu Sigma Youth Services has partnered with several organizations and agencies to fill these slots. These include referrals from the Philadelphia Youth Network, Department of Human Services, Philadelphia Family Court, Youth Violence Reduction Project, the Mural Arts Program in addition to youth who are already participating in other Nu Sigma Youth Services activities.



### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The Summer Enrichment and Employment Program is open to any resident of the city of Philadelphia who meets these qualifications:

- ◆ Resident of Philadelphia, PA
- ◆ At least 14 years old
- ◆ Ability to work during the day
- ◆ Valid Social Security Card

(Must have proof of the above)
